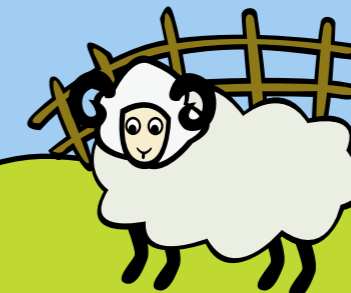
Stuff about the planet Earth:
