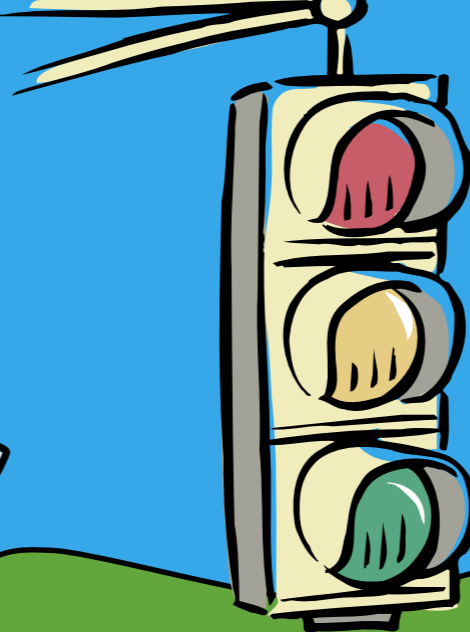

Before the summer hols are here, there's plenty of work to be done. Look for these hidden words:

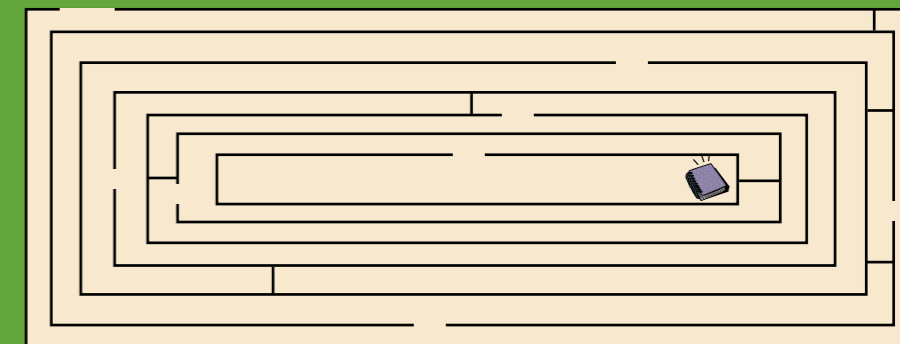
