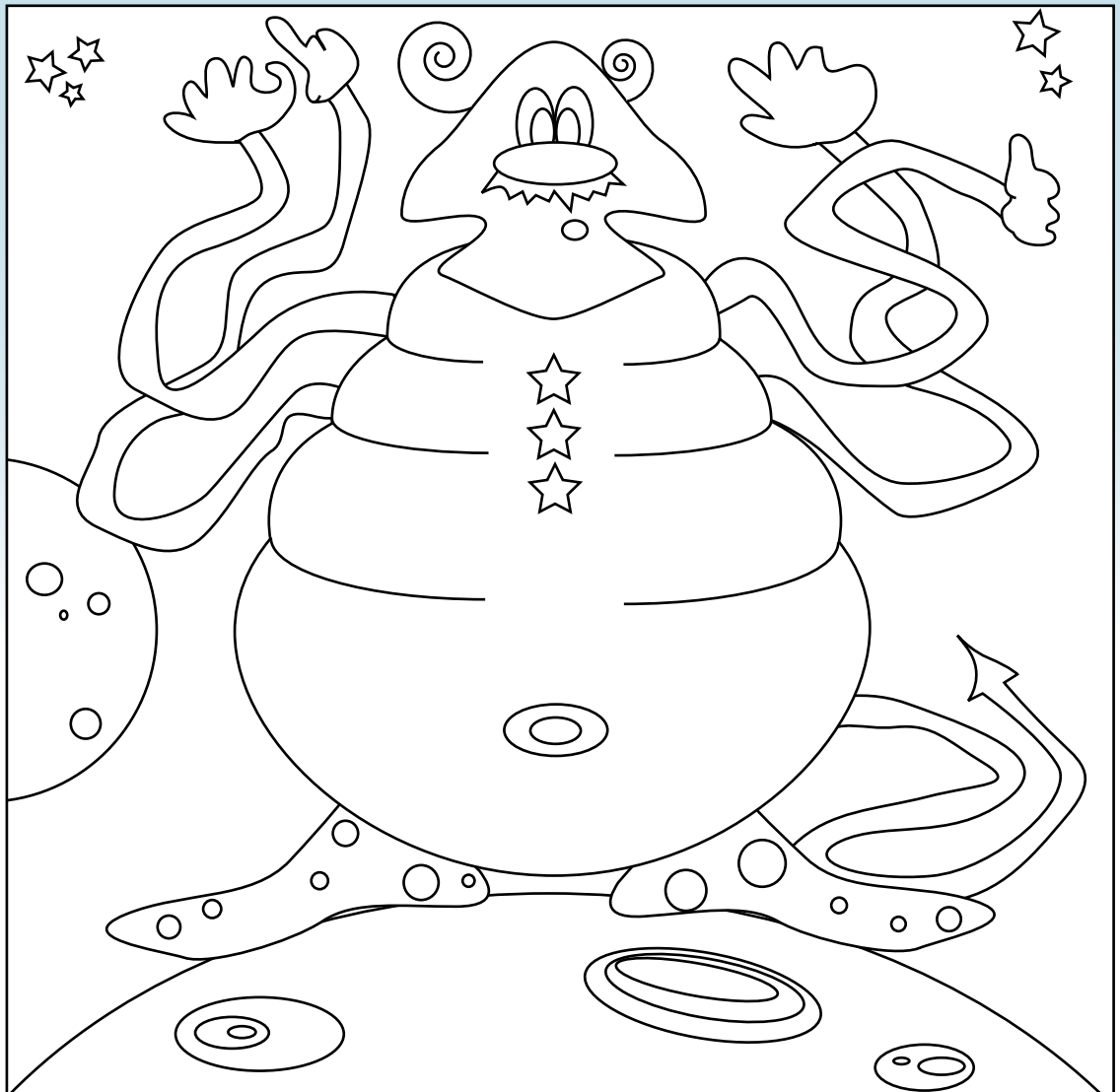
## Did YOU Know?
