Hello my friends and welcome to another 'That's The Story' newsletter. There's a lot to let you in on this month.

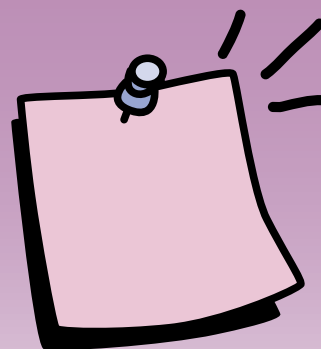
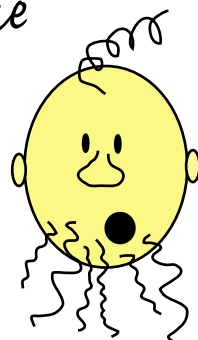

Crossword

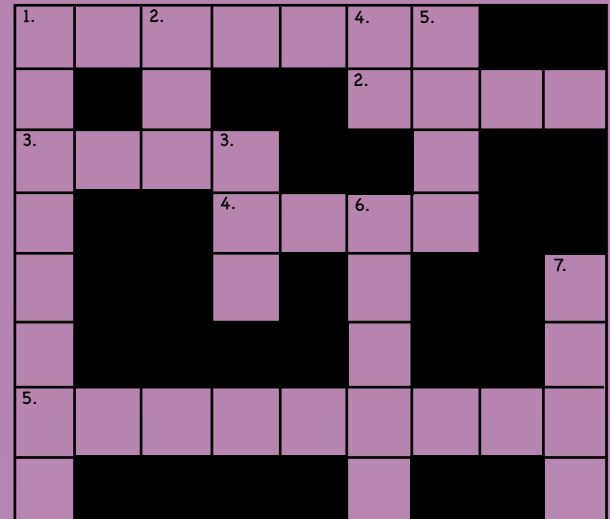
Using the clues below, work out which words need to go where and fill in the blanks of the crossword.

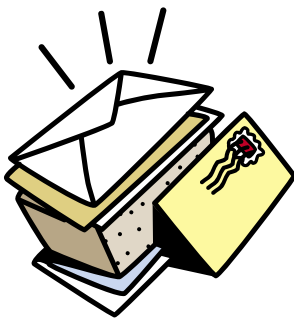
