




Beach Art

Next time you're at the beach, collect lots of 'beach treasures' such as seaweed, sponges, shells, small stones, coloured glass, small pieces of driftwood, beach grass, etc.

One day when the kids are bored, or it's raining, spread out your treasures on a table top and get some **strong PVA glue**, some **brushes** and some pieces of **cardboard**.

This can get quite messy so you may wish to cover your table with newspaper first, or work on a table outside if you can.



Using a piece of cardboard as a 'canvas' or base, glue on various objects to make a seascape collage or beach scene. If it's easier, you may wish to draw out a design in pencil first before you start glueing the pieces on. You'll be amazed at what can be created and the artworks will also hold special memories of a particular day or holiday for your children.
