

# Guess Who I Am?

A really simple game that the whole family can enjoy. All you need are some post-it notes and a couple of pens. (If you don't have post-it notes, paper and sellotape will do).

**Instructions:** Each person playing is given a piece of paper and a pen. Without letting anybody see their paper, each person writes down the name of somebody famous on it. They then stick it to the forehead of another player. Each player in the room should end up with a piece of paper stuck to their face! They have no idea what's written upon it, but everybody else can see. Player one begins by asking a question of another player in the hope of guessing the name of the person on their head. Players can only receive a 'yes' or 'no' answer to their question. Only one question can be asked at a time, before moving on to the next player. The aim is to guess the famous person by asking the **least** amount questions. You may find it helpful if one player keeps score of the number of questions asked per player.

This game helps increase general knowledge as well as being fun and interactive. Example starting questions could be: "Am I female?", "Am I an actor?", "Do I have dark hair?" etc.
