

Paper Golf

Golf is hugely popular these days with famous stars such as Tiger Woods on the touring circuit. This simple game is based on the real thing but all you need for this is a **sheet of A4 paper** and a **marker pen** (much cheaper!). Everyone has the same handicap (eyes closed) so all players are even.

How to play: create a 'fairway' on the paper (a shape that marks out the boundary for the tee-off area and hole). Draw a small circle (the hole) at one end of the fairway. Player one places the marker, point down, at the tee (the other end of the fairway), shuts their eyes and tries to draw a line to the hole. This is their 'shot'. The next player then tees off on the same sheet of paper (you may wish to use different coloured markers for each player). As with real golf, the player furthest from the hole shoots first and your score is the number of shots it takes you to reach the hole. The player with the least shots is the winner. Play nine holes or even 18, just like the pros... use a sheet of A3 or larger if you want to get really bold!
